FESTIVAL OF WATER

PROGRAMME

Films have always been a popular medium to reach out to all sections of the society, particularly the young generation to spread any important message; thus spearheading the "NirDhwani Festival".

The two day festival will be dedicated to the marine ecosystem and the freshwater systems. The inter-day structure will be same for both the days with sessions spread across the following:

- Entertainment & Engagement (art, tourism, adventure & sports)
- Business ideas and management (new ideas and start-up possibilities)
- Concerns (environmental and sustainability issues)
- Content Creation through film making to spread social messages
- Science and Technology Communication
- Geo-politics on water related issues

The sessions will to address multiple broader issues of policy, technology, economics, diplomacy and many more. The format of the session will be to play the film for a duration of 30 minutes and then have an expert or the film maker or even a panel of related individuals interacting with the audience.

Along with the films we would like to promote interaction with water through art installations, music and engagement booths.
